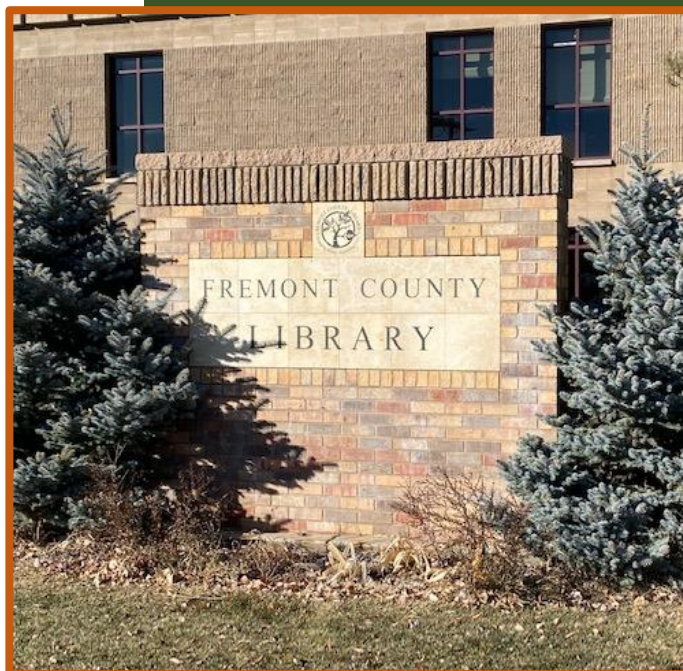

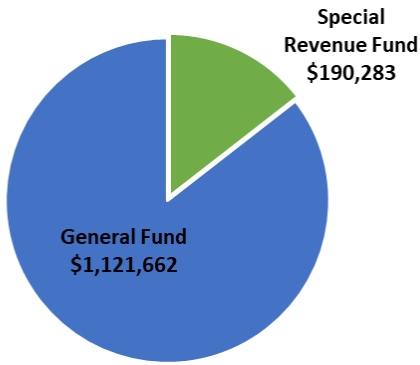

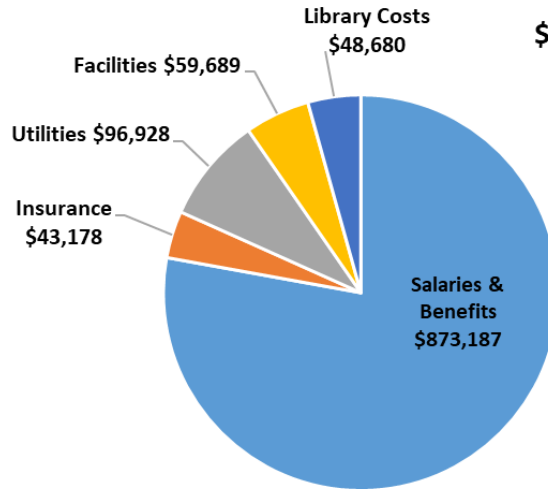

# Budget Information Fiscal Year 2022-2023

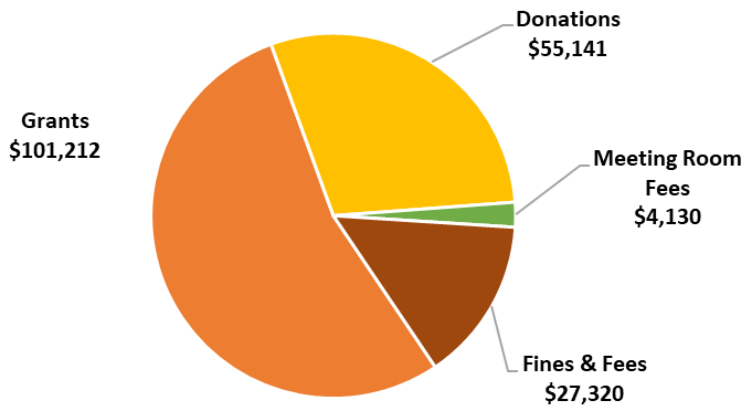
Total Library Budget SRF & GF \$1,311,945



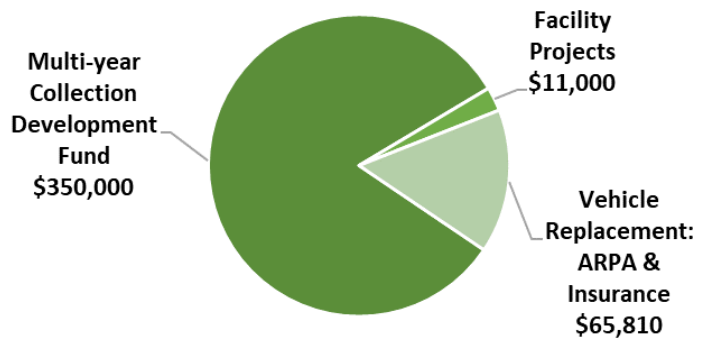
General Fund Budget \$1,121,662



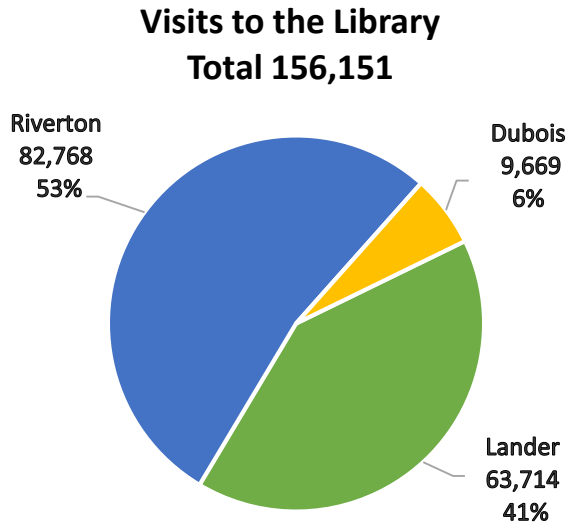
Self-Generated Revenue Total \$187,803

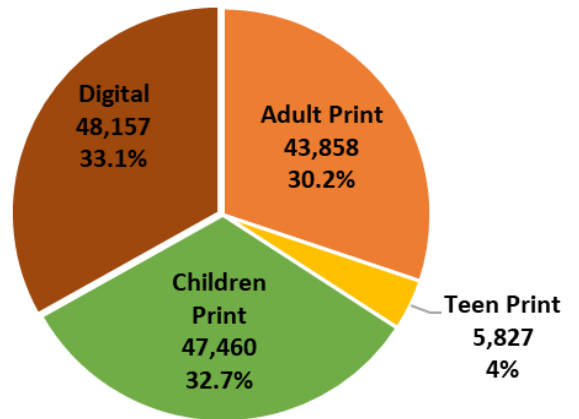

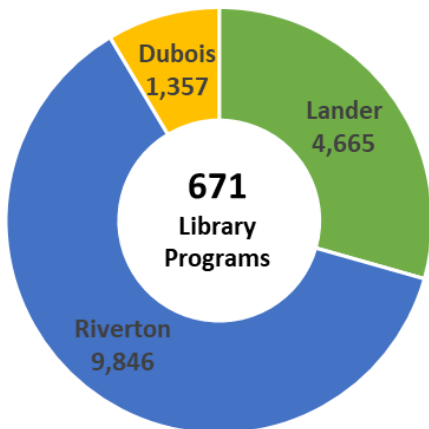

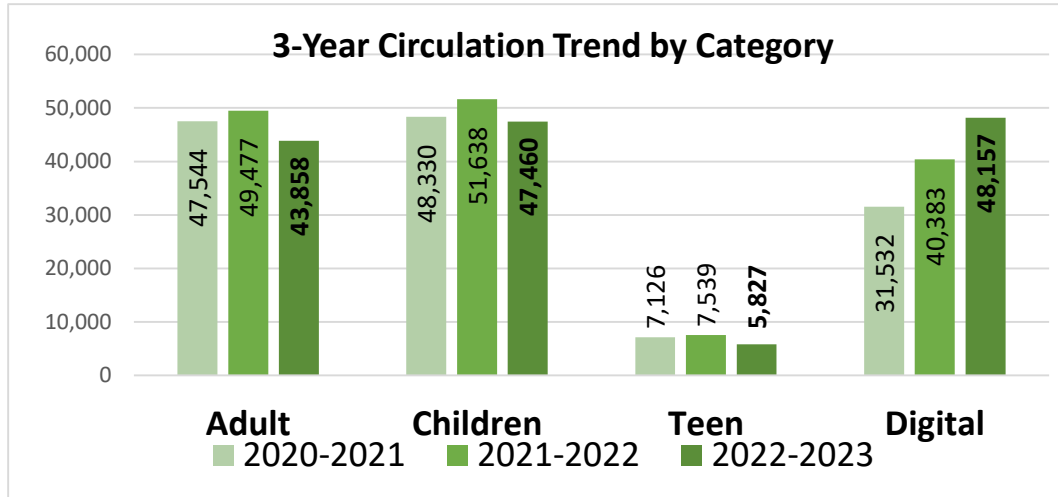
